Significant Humanitarian Facts



The markets in the Gaza Strip are experiencing a critical crisis, with prices soaring to unprecedented levels as a result of the blockade and the atrocities perpetrated by the Israeli occupation against the Palestinian population. (4)

- Fresh produce, eggs, and meat are in extremely limited supply, and their prices have reached alarming heights.
- International organizations, including the United Nations, have issued warnings that famine has been officially declared in the northern Gaza Strip, a situation exacerbated by the ongoing genocide that began on October 7, alongside a military blockade that has obstructed the delivery of essential food, water, and medical supplies.



The enactment of legislation by the Israeli Knesset aimed at dismantling UNRWA would have devastating repercussions: (5)

- Dismantling UNRWA would result in the collapse of the United Nations' humanitarian efforts in Gaza, which are heavily dependent on the agency's existing infrastructure, thereby denying half a million Palestinian refugees' access to essential health care services in the West Bank.
- If the agency were to cease operations in Gaza due to the new Israeli legislation, an entire generation of Palestinian children would be deprived of their right to education.



The Civil Defense Agency has reported that its operations remain forcibly halted across all regions of the northern Gaza Strip due to the continuous Israeli attacks and aggression, leaving thousands of citizens without access to humanitarian and medical assistance.

In recent weeks, a significant crisis has emerged in the central and southern regions of the Gaza Strip, as flour and essential supplies have depleted from both markets and Palestinian households. This dire situation has compelled families to resort to using spoiled flour for sustenance and to seek out unhealthy alternatives. (4)



Human Rights Watch has reported that there is no credible military justification for Israel's mass displacement of nearly all residents of Gaza. (6)

-The organization highlighted that Israel's evacuation policies have caused considerable harm to the population, often aimed solely at instilling fear and anxiety. Rather than ensuring the safety of displaced civilians, Israeli forces have consistently obstructed evacuation routes and designated safe zones.

- Furthermore, the organization has debunked Israeli assertions that the military has legally evacuated civilians to target armed groups within the population, claiming that such actions are intended to reduce civilian casualties. Their research substantiates that these claims are unfounded. A tent that has become dilapidated and unsuitable for the displaced.
